## HOW TO REGISTER YOUR IPAD/IPOD ON THE WIRELESS NETWORK

Before you can register your device on the CGCC wireless network, you will need to find the MAC (Media Access Control) address. For your iPad or iPod, you will go to Settings >> General >> About >> Wi-Fi address (this is the MAC address). Write down the alphanumeric WiFi (MAC) address so that you can use it to register your device on the CGCC website. FOR THE NEXT STEP, YOU MUST BE ON A COMPUTER THAT IS ALREADY CONNECTED TO THE NETWORK. This can be from home, or from a campus computer that has a connection.








Now that you have the MAC address of your device, go to <a href="http://www.cgc.maricopa.edu/academic-affairs/comp-lab/Pages/WirelessRegistration.aspx">http://www.cgc.maricopa.edu/academic-affairs/comp-lab/Pages/WirelessRegistration.aspx</a> (or, go to <a href="http://www.cgc.edu">http://www.cgc.edu</a> >> Quick Links pulldown menu >> Wireless Network) to get to the "Wireless Registration" page, and click to login and register your device:



You will be asked for authentication in order to access the network; just use your MEID username and password, as you do for everything else, then click "OK":



Now just enter the MAC address of your device, give it a brief description (for example, I have a laptop, and iPad, and an iPod registered, so it's good to have a unique identifier for each):



Once you hit "Submit," you should get a confirmation message. That's it – you are now ready to use the CGCC wireless network with your mobile device!
