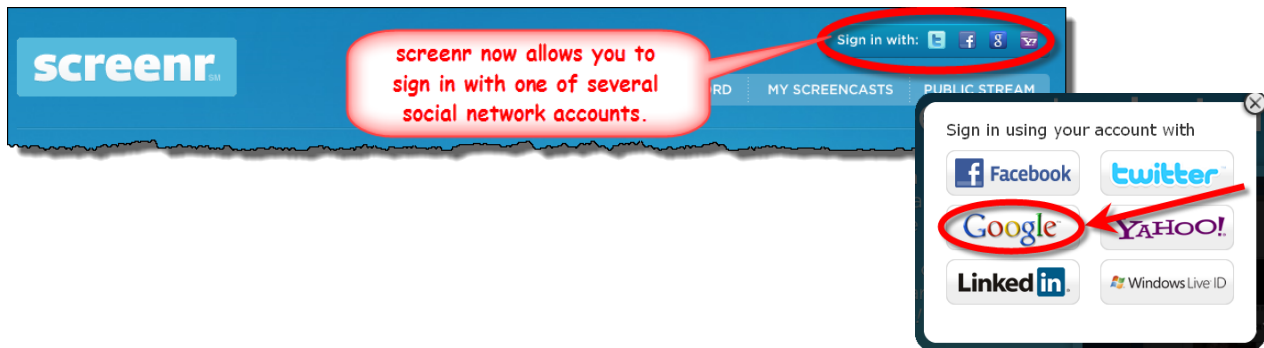


# USING YOUR CGC GMAIL ACCOUNT WITH

1. Go to <http://screenr.com>. You do not need to log in to actually *create* a screencast, but you will need to log in to share your screencast video when it is completed.

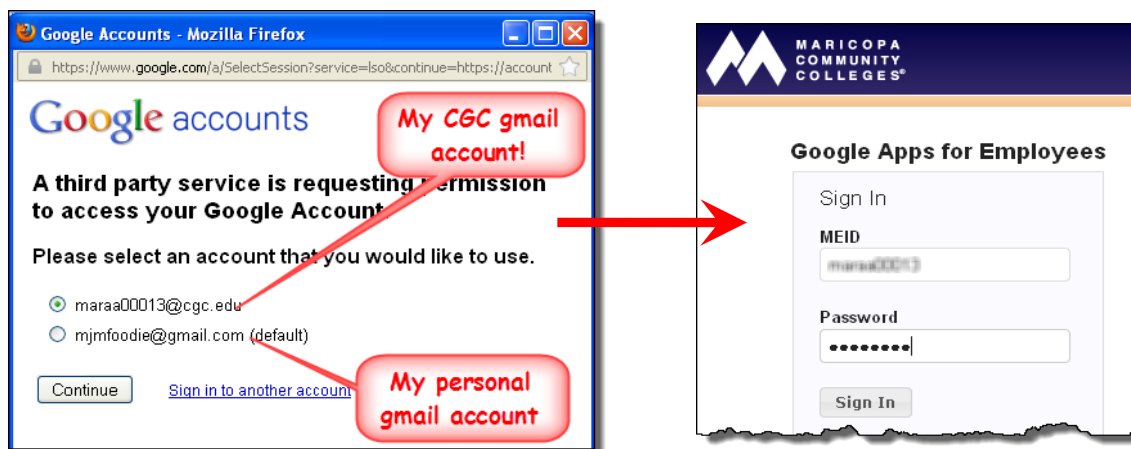
Screenr now allows you to log in using your existing account information with Twitter, Facebook, Google, Yahoo, LinkedIn, or Windows Live. To log into screenr using your [firstname.lastname@cgc.edu](mailto:firstname.lastname@cgc.edu) account (this works because these are actually Google accounts), first click the “Sign in with:” button in the top right corner, then select “Google” from the options that pop up:



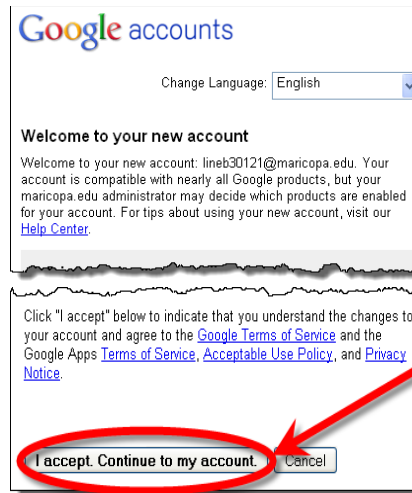
2. Enter your MEID login information, and click “Sign in.”

In my case, because I have a personal gmail account AND a work gmail account, I get a pop-up box asking which account I want to use. **DON'T BE CONFUSED – the [MEID@cgc.edu](mailto:MEID@cgc.edu) option actually IS the account for your gmail, even though your gmail address is [firstname.lastname@cgc.edu](mailto:firstname.lastname@cgc.edu).** I select my [MEID@cgc.edu](mailto:MEID@cgc.edu) account, then click “continue.”

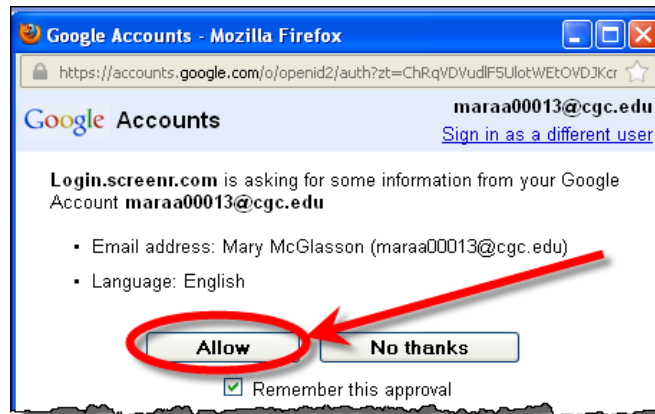
Now you will be taken to the MCCC login page. Complete your usual login information, and click “Sign In:”



3. **If this is your first time logging in**, you will get a “Welcome to your new account” message. To proceed, you will need to accept the terms of service by clicking the “I accept...” button at the bottom.



4. Once you have accepted the terms of service, Google Accounts will want to confirm that you want to allow screenr to connect with your Google account. Click "Allow."



Only one more step – choose a Screenr username, then click "Complete registration." You have completed your registration with screenr, using your [firstname.lastname@cgc.edu](mailto:firstname.lastname@cgc.edu) (CGC gmail) account!
